The caterers at QPCS, Alliance in Partnership, offer students and staff a varied choice of diet. The meals they provide are freshly prepared and cooked on the premises in the school dining hall, which has recently been refurbished in a modern design.

Students are able to purchase their lunch, in either of the two breaks, using the 'cashless' catering system which was introduced at the start of this year. The 'cashless' system is activated by students using either PIN numbers or biometric scans, at the time of taking lunch. The biometric (finger scan) system generates a unique numeric code from sections of a student's finger or thumb print - this means that a student can pay for their school meal without having to remember a PIN number.

Students can top-up their personal accounts using the on-site revalidation unit. Alternatively, parents can credit their child's account by using the Parent Pay on-line system.

Students are also welcome to bring their own packed lunch. We have several picnic tables, located around the school, so that students may eat their packed lunch outside during the nice weather.

Sometimes we have a special menu that relates to a particular celebration in the year e.g. Black History Month, Christmas and Chinese New Year.
